years of pastoring this good fundamental church and we praise the Lord for his taking the time to share his wisdom with our students at the Bible College.



We are very pleased to announce that **Dr. Dave Douglass** has been led of the Lord to become a stateside representative of our Bible College. Bro. Douglass will assist us in raising funds for the college, encouraging partnerships with the school as well as coming over periodically to teach classes when time allows. Bro. Douglass is an evangelist sent out of the Calvary Baptist Church in Middleburg, Florida.



We made our **initial contact in Abadasky** where our new church planting project will take place. Our Bible College staff and students, along with a few of our faithful church members and Bible College Representative, **Dr. Dave Douglass** saturated the area with the Gospel. We had over

150 professions of faith and made around 300 additional contacts for follow up. This area is a relocation area where nearly 37,000 people will be relocated. This community project has just started. **Hopefully, as this community grows, the Abadasky Baptist Church will grow with it.**
